All competitors are honorary members of the Salcombe Yacht Club for the duration of the Regatta.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: All races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 - 2016, the prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association and the rules of each Class concerned and the Sailing Instructions that shall be used to cover the regatta and this notice. All dinghies must have a valid Measurement Certificate with current buoyancy endorsement and third party insurance with a minimum cover of £1m, proof of which may be called for by the Race Committee. The Race Committee reserves the right to make any alterations it may deem necessary (see overleaf).

The Race Committee may at its discretion take out any class entered in the Handicap Class to provide them with class racing, similarly any class may be combined with the Handicap. It is regretted that entries cannot be accepted for multihulls or dinghies over 20ft. in length. There will be one discard if all races are sailed, no discard if four or less. Sailing Instructions may be collected from the Yacht Club.

The Time Limit will be 3 hours and any boat which fails to finish within this time shall be deemed to have retired. When no more boats will be credited with finishing, two sound signals will be sounded, and all signals except those indicating protests, lowered.

SAIL NUMBERS MUST BE COMPLETE AND CORRECT. Any boat sailing with a sail number other than as entered may be deemed not to have entered.

*The National Trust owns Millbay Car Park and the approach to the beach. Time will be allowed to unload boats but cars and road trailers must be removed from the road immediately.

ENTRIES

The entry form together with the fee (cheques payable to the Salcombe Town Regatta) should be posted to the Town Regatta Sailing Secretary, Shute End, Marlborough, Kingsbridge, TQ7 3SG, or placed in the box at the Salcombe Yacht Club to arrive no later than 1800hrs on Saturday 3rd August.

NO ACKNOWLEDGEMENT WILL BE SENT. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Regatta Secretary up to one hour before the start of the first race on Monday 5th August. **An extra charge of £5.00 will be made.** The entry fee is for the whole week's racing and there is no reduction if less than 5 races are sailed. I agree to the conditions of entry. I declare that I hold a current buoyancy certificate (where applicable) and a valid certificate of insurance with minimum third party cover of £1,000,000 which will cover me whilst racing in Salcombe Town Regatta. I understand that the Salcombe Town Regatta committee accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage, injury, or inconvenience to persons or yachts, however arising, directly or indirectly from their rules, policy or rulings during the races or related activities.

I accept full responsibility for the seaworthiness and safe navigation of the above yacht, and its crew shall use their own judgement whether to start, continue or retire from a race in the existing and forecast conditions. Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the yacht nor will it make the organisers responsible for loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the yacht taking part in racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the race and the event, and include the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, patrol boats and beach masters. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the yacht of its responsibilities.

I have read and agree to the above conditions of entry.

The sailing instructions for the event will be the Salcombe Yacht Club Sailing Instructions as amended or supplemented by this Notice. In the event of a conflict between the Salcombe Yacht Club Sailing Instructions and this Notice, this Notice will prevail. Amendments to this Notice and/or to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Town Regatta Notice Board in the Salcombe Yacht Club.

5 races are scheduled for each class (one per day).

A series for a class shall be constituted by the completion of any one of that class's races.

If 3 or more races are sailed there will be one discard. If 2 or fewer races are sailed there will be no discard.

All handicap classes must display stickers on the leech on either side of the mainsail. JAC - Green, Fast Handicap - Pink, Slow Handicap - Black. Collect from notice board at Salcombe Yacht Club.

For the Handicap and Junior All Comers Cup Classes the RYA's published Portsmouth Numbers will be used as the handicapping system.

The Slow and Fast Handicap classes will be split on receipt of entries and displayed on the notice board at the Salcombe Yacht Club on Sunday 8th August p.m.

The handicap classes are limited to boats with a maximum RYA Portsmouth no of 1220.

The Salcombe Yawl Red Fleet is for boats numbered 141 and above and for such other Salcombe Yawls as choose to enter it. The Blue Fleet is for all other Salcombe Yawls. Blue and Red stickers must be displayed as for Salcombe Yacht Club Regatta.

The Race Committee will comprise Nick Rowell, Judith Rowell and such other persons as they may appoint.

BOAT PARKING ON MILL BAY

Mill Bay is privately owned and use of the beach is at the discretion of the owners.

1. Sailing dinghies may only be parked on the beach with permission.
2. Permits are issued on a weekly basis (with a limit of four weeks) and must be displayed on the boats at all times. There is a recommended donation of £10 per week per boat, the surplus of which will go to local charities.
3. Permits can be purchased with a regatta application.
4. Boats left on the beach beyond their permit will be removed at the boat owners' expense.
5. All boats and accessories are left entirely at the boat owner's risk.

Please note that there is a section of the beach in front of the houses where boat parking will not be permitted. Please leave access to the estuary free for the residents and refer to the notices on the beach.

For the benefit of all, the owners request that:

1. No barbecues, fires or beach parties
2. No undue noise or loud music
3. Dogs should be kept on leashes between 10-5pm from May to September
4. All rubbish should be taken away
5. No outboards or road trailers to be left on the beach at any time
6. Night fishing only, seaward of Mill Bay
7. No mooring of any boats on the foreshore
8. No camping
9. No driving or parking of any motor vehicles

Boat owners racing in the Salcombe Yacht Club or Town regattas may obtain their permit with their regatta application. Other boat owners may obtain their permits from the Venus Café at the Ferry Steps, East Portlemouth.
